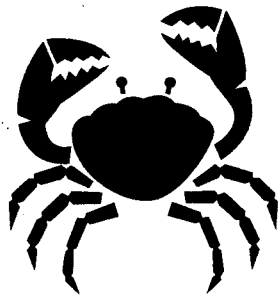

We have had some complaints about dogs running loose and un-

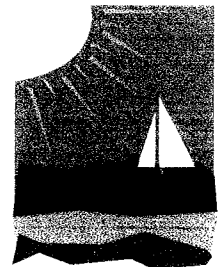
attended. Please keep your pet on a 6 foot leash and under control if outside the trailer or screen room.

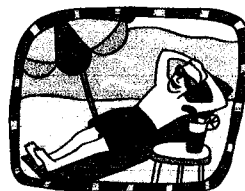

Purpose:

The purpose of the meeting was to provide information to the residents of happenings in the Port and to get feedback on Port operation.

Discussion:

R. Powell discussed the following items:

Electric bills will be issued in late June.

More sheds will be replaced, probably around 20. Those to be replaced will be determined by shed condition.

The renovation of the bathrooms is complete. Residents are urged to keep them clean or the Directors will keep them locked.

Please use the kayak racks to store your kayak. All kayaks must have a Port Sticker.

An AED/CPR refresher training course is scheduled for August.

Please keep the Rolodex up to date with address and phone number changes. If this information does change, please leave a note in the mailbox at the office so the Directors records can be kept current.

A motion light will be installed in the dumpster area.

There has been no action on the CJH request for a 50 foot right of way through the Port property.

Two leases have been terminated due to non payment of bills.

R. Powell opened the floor to questions and comments from the residents.

Steve Loden thanked those who helped with the shed replacement arrangements.

The Directors will undertake renovations in the kitchen.

The bathrooms look great.

The speed limit in the Port is 10 mph. Please observe it.

Recipe for May: Hot Crab Dip



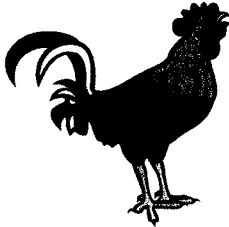
Ingredients:

1 pkg (3 oz) cream cheese, softened	1/2 c. mayonnaise
6 oz fresh crabmeat (or 1 can drained)	1/4 c. minced onion
1 Tbsp. lemon juice	1/8 tsp. tabasco sauce

Beat cream cheese until smooth. Stir in remaining ingredients. Spoon into small ovenproof dish. Bake at 350° F for 30 minutes or until bubbly. Makes 1 cup of dip.
