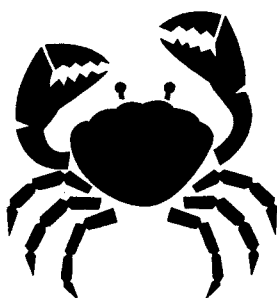

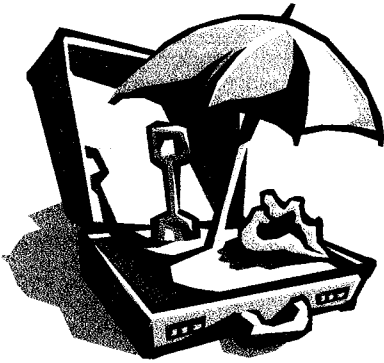

August's Recipe: Vegetable Beef Soup

This recipe comes from a dear friend who passed away recently. It is a great comfort food for cool fall afternoons.

Ingredients:

Soup bones and/or stew beef cubes
1 qt. canned tomatoes
1 pt. tomato juice
1 qt. plus 1 pt. water
1/3 c. chopped onion
1 Tbsp. salt
2 tsp. Worcestershire sauce
1/2 tsp. chili powder
2 bay leaves

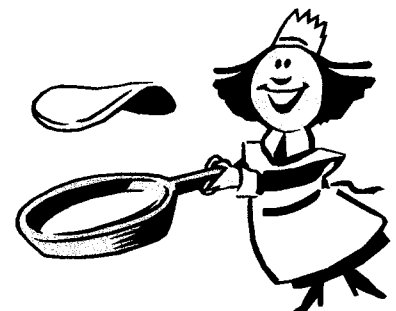
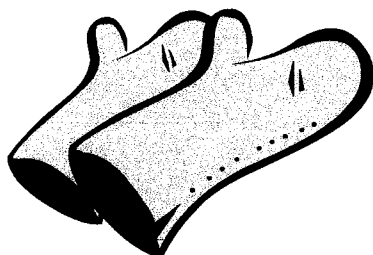
1 c. celery diced
1 c. cabbage, chopped
2 c. carrots, sliced
2 c. potatoes, diced
1 pt. green beans
1 pt. yellow beans (string)
1 pt. corn
1 pt. lima beans

Directions:

Add bones, beef cubes, tomatoes, tomato juice, water, onion, celery, and seasonings. Cover and simmer for 2 hours. Remove soup bones and cut off meat into small pieces. Add vegetables. Cover and simmer 1 hour longer. Add water with vegetables if needed.

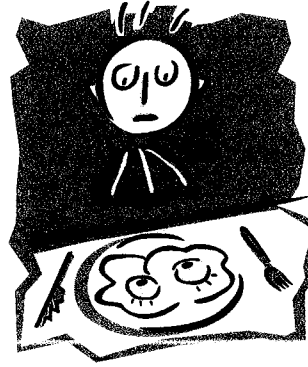

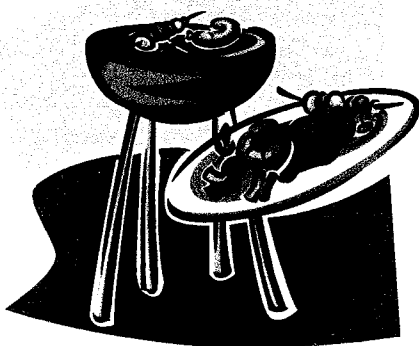
