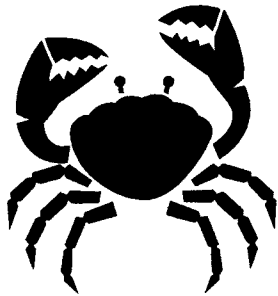

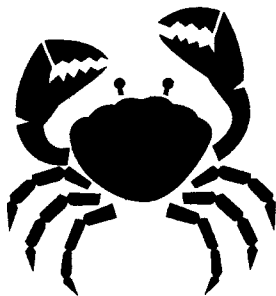

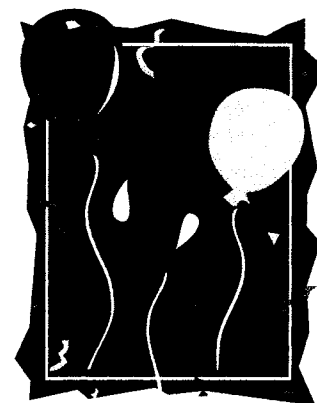

## July's Recipe: Baked Salmon Parmesan

This is Helen Storm's recipe from the Memorial Day Dinner.

### Ingredients:

1 lb salmon, cut into 4 serving pieces	1/3 c. low-fat mayonnaise
1/4 c. plus 2 Tbsp. Parmesan Cheese, grated	1/2 small onion, finely chopped
1 garlic clove, minced	2 Tbsp. fresh parsley, chopped
1/8 tsp. salt and pepper	
Garnish with lemon wedges	

### Directions:

Preheat oven to 450° F. Oil a baking sheet. Mix mayonnaise, 1/4 c. parmesan cheese, onion, garlic, parsley, salt and pepper in a small bowl. Lay the salmon on the baking sheet. Spread mixture over salmon. Sprinkle remaining parmesan cheese on top. Bake uncovered for 12 minutes, or until the salmon reaches the internal temperature of 145° F.

You can also substitute mahi-mahi, tuna or swordfish for the salmon.

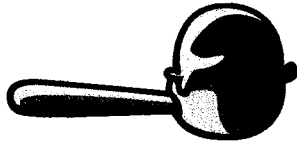
